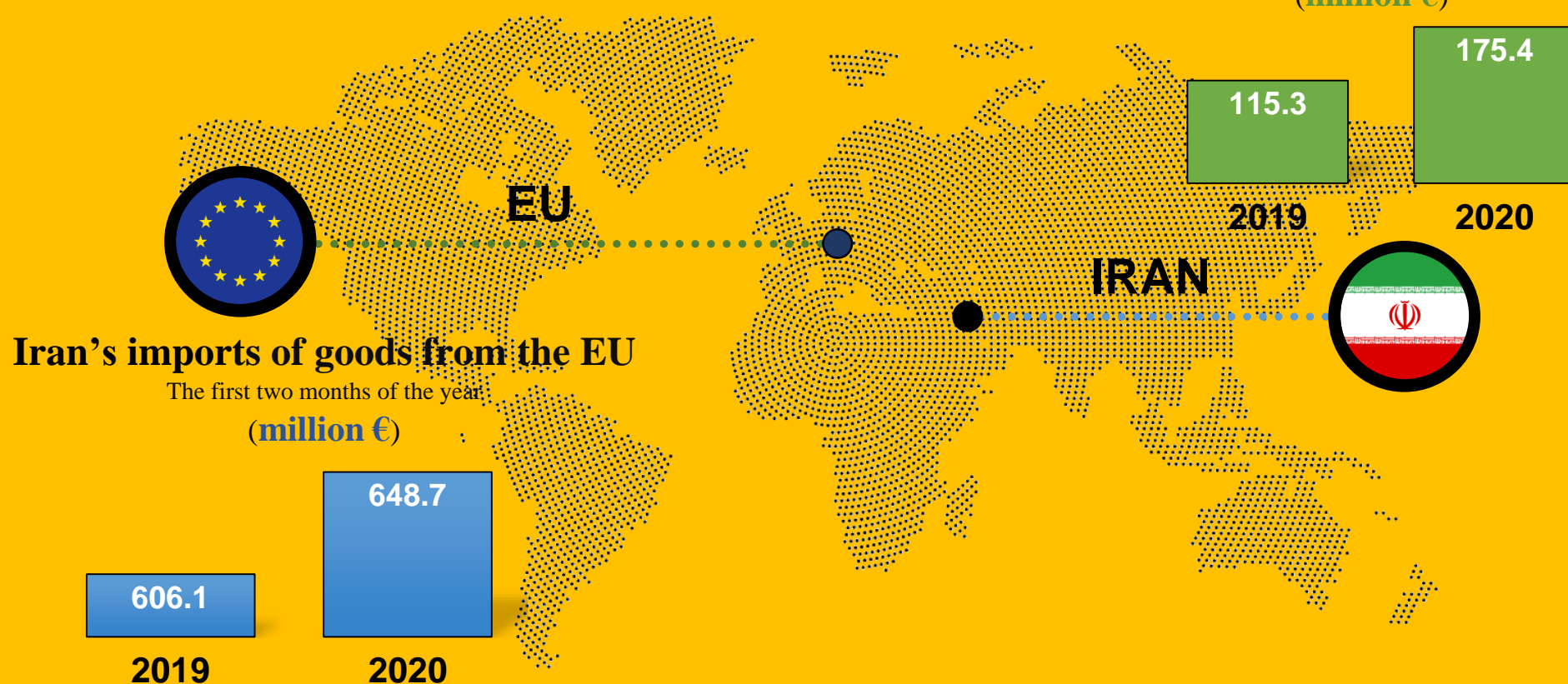

Iran's exports of goods to the EU

The first two months of the year

Iran's exports of goods to the EU in the first two months of 2020 (January and December) recorded a **52%** increase compared to the same period of 2019. Meanwhile, Iran's goods import from the EU experienced a **7%** growth.

- "Food and live animals" category has contributed to **38%** of Iran's goods export to the EU and **17%** of Iran's import of goods from the EU, in the first two months of 2020.
- While in 2019 "Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials" category accounted for only **0.3%** of Iran's export to the EU, its share has risen to **20%** in the first two months of 2020.
